An Important Question from DPP

Dear Sir

On Tuesday 31/07/2007 I sent you a fax and explained that I have sent you a letter dated 30/07/2007 regarding **instructing terrorists** and I respectfully requested you to read that letter as soon as possible. Today I have received a reply letter dated 1/08/2007 from Mr. Glenn Theakston that says: "If you are of the view that a commonwealth offence has been committed, you should consider referring the allegation to the AFP".

I have a question and I appreciate if you answer this question:

If an Australian citizen (specially if he/she is Non Muslim) witnesses a terrorist activity in Australia , and is not sure that the report to which governmental department should be sent , and instead of calling national security hotline or contacting AFP, sends the report to DPP, will DPP immediately contact AFP and ask AFP to investigate about that terrorist threat ? Or will send a reply letter to the reporter that: sorry this is not related to us, you should contact AFP if you think there is any terrorist threat?

I respectfully request you to please only answer this question. I wait for your reply.
