Re: The Predictable Result

Thank you for your letter which by mistake was dated 3 October 2007, and it was a reply to my fax dated 5 October 2007.

In your recent letter you have mentioned that **ACMA can not investigate whether or not the broadcast of 'Sunrise' on 4 July 2007 might cause damage for Australia, Australians and human rights.**

Also in another letter actual dated 3 October 2007 you have mentioned that **ACMA has decided to investigate your complaint that these comments were insulting to Muslims and discriminated against Muslims.**

ACMA can only investigate whether or not those comments were insulting to **Muslims**, not all Australians! Only Muslims. This is interesting. The code doesn't let ACMA investigate whether or not Australians were insulted. The code will only let ACMA to investigate whether or not Muslims were insulted.

As you have requested, I will wait till investigation is finalized. I appreciate ACMA for spending time to investigate, but if you do not mind I want to predict the result of the investigation now:

If ACMA wants to investigate whether or not **Muslims were insulted, without including Non Muslims in the investigations**, in that case I predict that the result of the investigation will be something similar to this sentence but of course by nicer words and better English than mine:

ACMA has finalised the investigations and the result is that: Muslims have not been insulted by the broadcast of Channel 7, also it has not discriminated against Muslims.
